



# Promising prospects for physics graduates

£3.000 after one year in employment more than the average graduate. Increase in unemployed physics graduates lower than average increase. Data collected by the Institute of Physics (IOP) between 2006 and 2010 demonstrates the potential rewards on offer to those who study physics at university.

Data shows that, while the majority of those who study physics (52.4%) go on to further study (studying for Master's and PhDs), those who go into employment earn an annual salary almost £3,000 more than graduates of all

The data, gathered from almost 6,000 final year graduates from 55 universities between 2006 and 2010, suggests the average salary for a physics graduate one year after graduation is £22,500, contrasting favorably to the average graduate salary in 2008 of £19.700.

The unemployment rate is significantly lower among physics graduates than all graduates - in 2007 8% of physics graduates were unemployed, while the national average for all graduates stood at 18% - and the increase in graduate unemployment
