
The game states that to finish it will take more than 45 minutes. This is a good guide as we finished a game with 4 players in just over an hour. The instructions are clear and easy to follow. There are two ways to score and collect scoring pieces; by answering questions or by landing on certain spaces and then throwing a die to show specific numbers. This means that a player without specialist Thunderbirds knowledge still has a fair chance of scoring. As the

questions are multiple choice, you can always have a guess and even our resident expert did not know all the answers!

Once a person has collected all their scoring pieces they can move on to the next stage of answering questions which is when the picture cards come into play. These show scenes and characters from the episodes which may or may not help with the answer. Again, these are multiple choice so you are still in with a 1 in 3 chance of accurate guess Good fun to play, and it didn't go on for too long ... all necessary criteria for playing board games in these gadget / i-pad times



The Razar Party Pop Kick Scooter

The Razor Party Pop Kick Scooter (quite a name!) is known as a 'party on wheels'. It's outstanding feature setting it aside from other scooters is it 12 multi coloured LED lights in the polypropylene deck and its vibrant wheels. The scooter also has a unique white and purple colour scheme which cleverly compliments the bright LED light scheme. The lightweight steel frame and urethane wheels, which interestingly are more commonly used for skateboards, allows the rider to enjoy a smoother and faster



fast on this scooter the rear footbrake, anti slip footplate and easy grip handles are quite an important safety feature. My daughter in particular liked the foam covering on the handle bars, making it a very comfortable grip for her when scooting. As the footplate is slightly higher than some of the other scooters, it is a real thrilling ride, living up to it party pop kick scooter name. The LED lights after dusk are stunning. Unlike most other Razar scooters the handle bar is not adjustable, which is probably why the scooter is aimed at the 6 + age group. The height it is set at was more than suitable for my 8 year old daughter, who is actually quite petit for her age group. As the scooter also has a maximum weight of 100kg it could quite easily be used by adults as well. I do like the foldable element as it allows for easy storing when not in use and can be easily carried home after dropping kids to school. As a parent I was quite worried about this scooter being stolen as it is quite pretty and unique, so I would recommend a lock if keeping it in school grounds or a front garden. This scooter is really something special and given its £39.99 price tag it is a real bargain, so all in all a huge thumbs up for the Razor Party Pop Kick Scooter. Party Pop is 6+



Too posh to push?

~ the health implications of a vaginal delivery to the mother

It is broadly acknowledged that trends in childbirth have changed significantly. This shift has had various implications. among which the rise in caesarean section rates are one of them. But, what are the reasons for mother's wanting their babies to be delivered via caesarean section? Are mum's to be simply too posh to push?

Benefits of a vaginal delivery The benefits of a vaginal delivery are well-known and it potentially outweighs the risks (trauma and tears) or medium to long-term consequences on the pelvic floor. Caesarean section carries a potentially serious risk to both mums and babies (prolonged hospital stay, increased risk of infection and bleeding and breathing difficulties for the newborn). All these factors require consideration when deciding on your preferred mode of delivery.

What are the potential adverse consequences of a vaginal

The percentage of women suffering from urinary incontinence and vaginal prolapse (loss of support for the uterus, bladder or bowel) 35% and 50% respectively according to reasonably sizeable epidemiological studies. There are a substantial numbers of women struggling with problems after a vaginal delivery and that could be attributed to the impact of pregnancy on the pelvic floor and their wish to deliver via caesarian section.

Childbirth is also an

independent risk factor for developing prolapse; women who give birth to just one child have a two-fold increased risk of developing a lax vagina which might fall out of it's normal position in comparison to those who have not had children. Each additional child birth adds a further 10-20% increase in risk. The link between childbirth and urinary incontinence is stronger; a single delivery increases a woman's risk of developing urinary incontinence by 40% and this risk is further increased by almost 100% with a higher number after every delivery. More babies increases the chances of a woman developing urinary incontinence and/or vaginal prolapse at some point in her life.

Does a caesarean section protect your pelvic floor? There is evidence to suggest that a caesarean section will significantly reduce your risk of developing stress incontinence by almost 50%. There is also a lesser risk of developing

prolapse, in comparison to women who had a vaginal delivery

Another point that needs to be made is that symptoms of a weakened pelvic floor manifest not only after childbirth, but also during pregnancy, which implies a link between incontinence and prolapse with pregnancy itself rather than mode of delivery alone.

In conclusion, although caesarean section seems to be protective of a woman's pelvic floor, a decision for an elective caesarean delivery needs to be cautiously made after risks and benefits are thoroughly balanced against individual aims and risk factors

Consult your doctor or midwife:

- * For an objective appraisal on the advantages and disadvantages of a vaginal delivery
- To discuss how you might prevent prolapse or incontinence in pregnancy and after child birth
- * At six weeks post-partum if there are concerns about prolapse or incontinence
- If you develop incontinence or prolapse later on




